Different types of gifts

This type of charitable giving gives the donor an option of receiving an income in their lifetime and then leaving a legacy that will serve the Church in perpetuity. You can give a gift (minimum \$10,000), and receive between 5% and 8% every year. The donor receives tax incentives, and then at the death of the donor, the income supports the charity.

We have many contributors who have remembered to leave us a gift in their will.

This continues the work of The Association of the Miraculous Medal and makes a powerful statement to your children about generosity.

Sometimes gifts of appreciated assets of land and stock are a good way to help us.

Some families make a charitable organization a trust beneficiary, just like they do members of their family.
